8. ADOPTION OF THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR BUDGET

MOTION: Move that the Board adopt the final budget for the 2020-2021 school year.

WHEREAS, the Lacey Township School District Board of Education adopted a tentative budget on March 18, 2020 to be submitted to the Executive County Superintendent of Schools for approval, and

WHEREAS, the tentative budget was approved by the Executive County Superintendent of Schools on April 8, 2020 and

WHEREAS, the approved budget was advertised in the legal section of the Asbury Park Press and the Beacon on April 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the approved budget was presented to the public during a public hearing on May 4, 2020;

WHEREAS, subsequent to the public hearing the approved budget was amended to include revisions as outlined above;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the budget - as amended be adopted for the 2020-2021 school year using the 2019-2020 state aid figures and the Secretary to the Board of Education be authorized to submit the following adopted budget to the Executive County Superintendent of Schools in accordance with the statutory deadline:

And to advertise said tentative budget in the Asbury Park Press newspaper in accordance with the form suggested by the State Department of Education and according to law; and

Adjustment for Use of Banked Cap

BE IT RESOLVED that the Lacey Township Board of Education includes in the proposed budget the adjustment for banked cap in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-10.3(b). The district has fully exhausted all eligible statutory spending authority and must increase the base budget in the amount of \$383,391 for the purposes of maintaining instructional programs and staff. The district intends to complete said purposes by June 2021.

Capital Reserve Withdrawal - Excess Cost

Included in budget line 620, Budgeted Withdrawal from Capital Reserve – Excess Costs & Other Capital Projects, is \$980,000 that is for other capital projects - the replacement of boilers at the Lacey Township High School. The total cost of this project is estimated to be \$980,000 which represents expenditures for construction elements or projects that are in addition to the facilities efficiency standards determined by the Commissioner as necessary to achieve the New Jersey Student Learning Standards.

Maintenance Reserve Withdrawal

BE IT RESOLVED that, per N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-14.2, the Board of Education includes in the proposed budget the withdrawal of \$300,000 from the Maintenance Reserve Account. The district has fully exhausted all eligible statutory spending authority for required maintenance and must increase the base budget for the purposes of maintaining its facilities - specifically, various plumbing, electrical, and mechanical projects as outlined in the Comprehensive Maintenance Plan for account 11-000-261-420. The district intends to complete said purposes by June 2021.

Travel and Related Expense Reimbursement

WHEREAS, the Lacey Township Board of Education recognizes school staff and Board members will incur travel expenses related to and within the scope of their current responsibilities and for travel that promotes the delivery of instruction or furthers the efficient operation of the school district; and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.2 et seq. requires Board members to receive approval of these expenses by a majority of the full voting membership of the Board and staff members to receive prior approval of these expenses by the Superintendent of Schools and a majority of the full voting membership of the Board; and WHEREAS, the Lacey Township Board of Education established \$71,323 as the maximum travel amount for the current school year and has expended \$42,444 as of this date; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Education approves travel and related expense reimbursements in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.3, to a maximum expenditure of \$69,450 for all staff and board members for the 2020-2021 school year.

Alternative Revenue Projection - SEMI

Move that the Board of Education approve an alternate revenue projection of \$50,899 for the 2020-2021 Special Education Medicaid Initiative (SEMI) program as approved by the Ocean County Interim Executive County Superintendent.

Authorization to Implement the 2020-2021 Budget

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Lacey Township School District Board of Education authorize the Superintendent and Business Administrator/Board Secretary to implement the 2020-2021 budget pursuant to local and state policies.

A4F – Tax Levy Certification Forms A and B

BE IT RESOLVED, that the amount required for school purposes in the school district of Lacey Township, County of Ocean for the 2020-2021 school year is \$52,853,950 and is required to be levied for local school district purposes.
