Dear Parents/Guardians,

If it is necessary for your child to take any medication in school, (prescribed or over the counter medication), the following procedure must be observed.

- 1. A written document from the medical provider stating
  - a) The diagnosis
  - b) Name of medicine
  - c) Dosage, frequency, and time medication is to be administered
  - d) Duration
  - e) Side effects and restrictions

Physician's documentation can be faxed to the Health Office at (609) 971-2057

2. The medication must be brought to the School Nurse by the Parent / Guardian, in the original labeled bottle or container. All medications are kept in the Health Office. Medication prescribed three times a day should be taken before school, after school, and at bedtime.
