

## Important Information

- ~ Immunizations II is VERY important that the Health office has a copy of your child's immunizations for the first day of school.
- Name Tags are suggested, with your child's name, bus #, and teacher. Please attach a name tag to your child's backpack to assist our staff in identifying our Kindergarten student's as they arrive off the buses on the first day of in-person/Hybrid instruction.



~ Emergency information: This will be sent home with your child on the first day of Hybrid in-person instruction. This information is VITAL for our records. The nurse and main office keep copies of this to reach you. You need to have as many contacts as possible. Check that you have a functioning voice mail box. If you change your phone number, update us immediately.

- ~ Papers to return signed: (Once Hybrid Cohort begins) Backpacked home
  - Health History Questionnaire
  - Media Releasé / FERPA Information
  - Technology Agreement
  - Waker/Biker Pick Up MUST BE ALL 5 DAYS
  - Free/Reduced meal benefits

- ~ <u>Child Care</u>: **Champions (private company not run by the school)** Before & Aftercare available, see school website for information and link to the Champions site. They have very specific rules for scheduling.
- ~ <u>Parent Portal</u>: All students have an online portal housing their report cards each marking period. Other information found there: Pupil Records Policy, HIB policy, etc. All documents in the portal need to be reviewed and electronically acknowledged.
- ~ <u>Breakfast / Lunch:</u> Offered each day, see calendar for daily menu. Pay through "payschools" or send money in a labeled envelope with child's name and class. All students are given a card with a barcode that tracks their purchases. These cards stay in the lunchroom. The account follows your child through grade 12. **NEVV: Daily online ordering**

- ~ <u>Future Informational Paperwork</u>: Throughout the year, this can be found in your child's google classroom, papers sent home via email, or backpacked starting the 21st (Hybrid cohorts), and the parent portal. Check these locations frequently. You will also receive periodic "CCS Weekly News" from Mrs. Ranuska.
- ~ There are no field trips for the 20-21 school year.
- ~ There will be no class parties or guests to the classrooms until further notice.

### Security Procedures

- ~ <u>Vestibule</u> (new as of last year) We have a morning/afternoon greeter.
  - Visitors to the school are by <u>appointment only</u>.
  - All doors of the school are locked at all times.
  - If you are visiting the school, ring the bell on the wall outside, state
    who you are and why you are visiting. The greeter will meet you and
    take your temperature before you are admitted into the vestibule.
  - You must present the greeter with your identification (valid drivers' license).

- From the driver's license, the greeter will print a sticker/badge for you to wear. Only then will you be buzzed into the main entrance.
   We encourage making an appointment prior to arrival if you need to meet with someone.
- When you are leaving, you will return the sticker/badge and receive your identification back
- ~ <u>Dropping off of items</u>: All items can be dropped off with the greeter in the vestibule.
- ~ <u>Security Drills</u>: Fire drills & lockdown drills occur twice a month (1 each) ALICE protocols: Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, Evacuate

- ~ Morning Drop Off: All **non bus** riding students can be dropped off starting at **9:45**. Cars can pull into the drop off lane parallel to the median. A staff member will open the car door where your child is seated and take their temperature. Students registering with a temperature under 100 will be permitted to enter the school. The staff member will assist your child out of the vehicle and guide them into the school building.
- ~ Afternoon Pick Up All walkers (5 days a week) will be released at approximately 2:20pm after all buses have left. No parents will be permitted into the building. At approximately 2:20 pm, a staff member will bring your child out of the building to meet you by the front entrance.
