

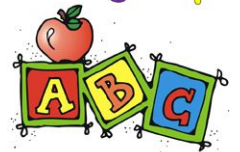

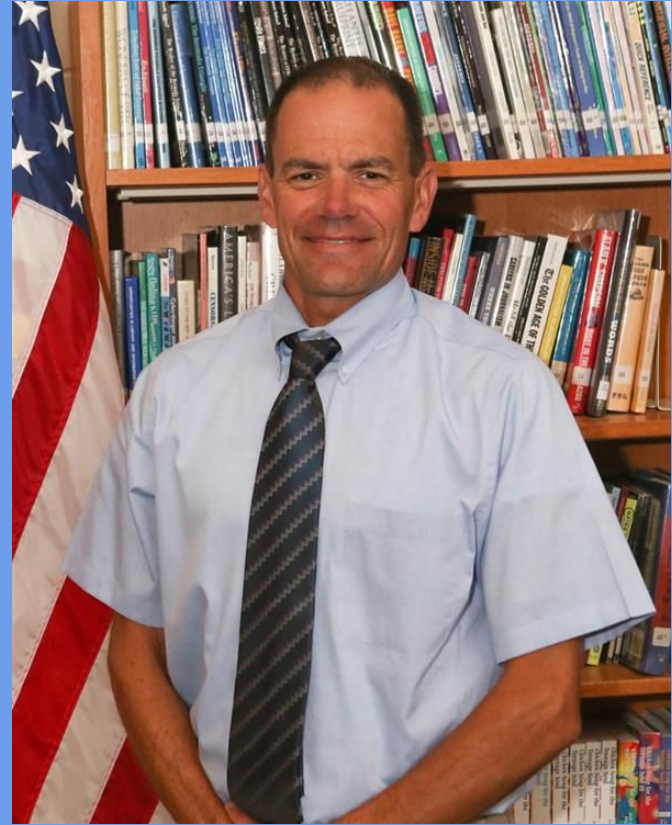

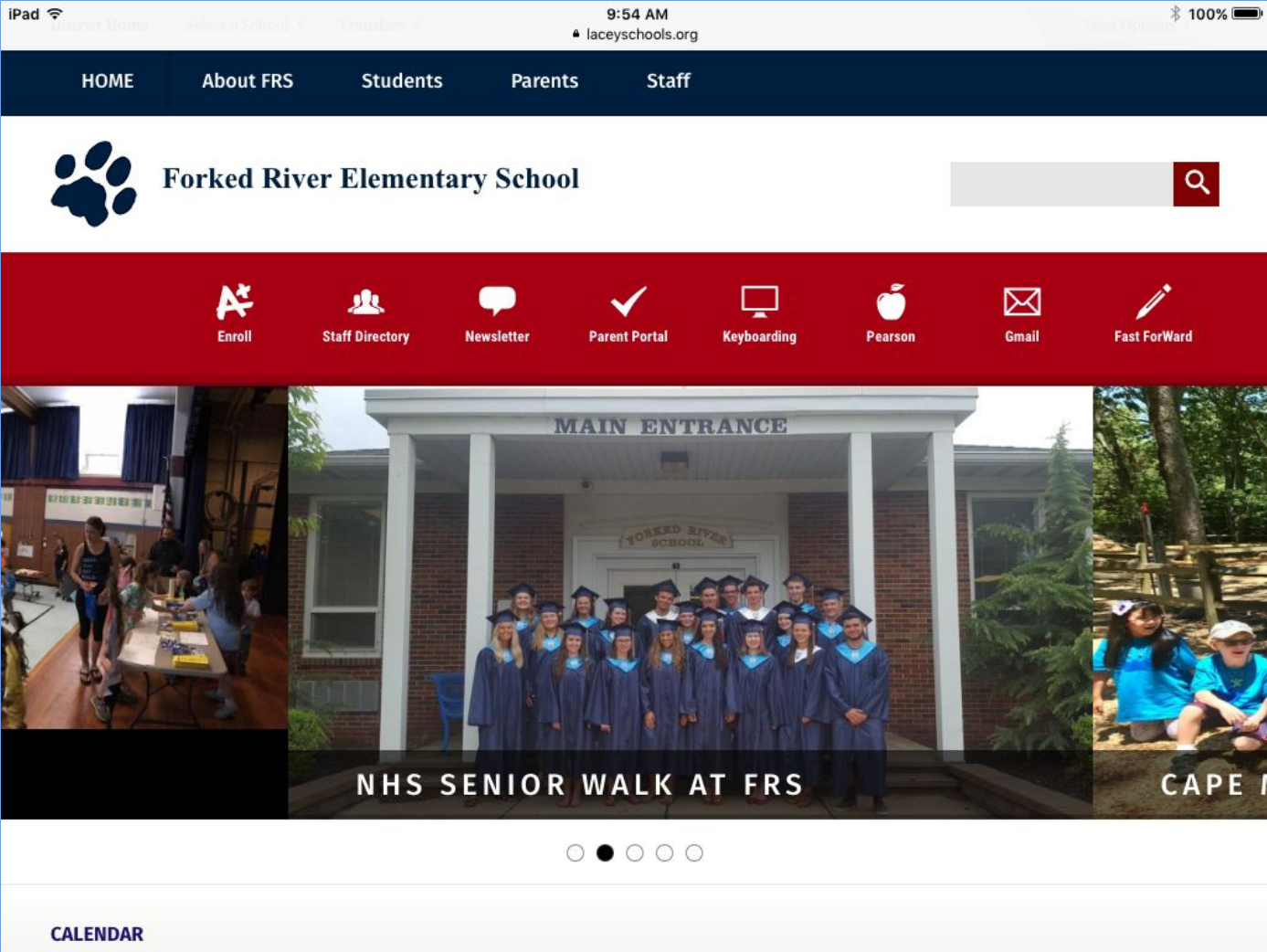


Fully-Remote Cohort Schedule

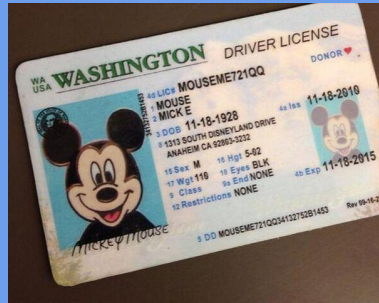
ALICE Protocol

All Lacey Township School District employees are certified in the ALICE safety protocol which includes:

- Alert
- Lockdown

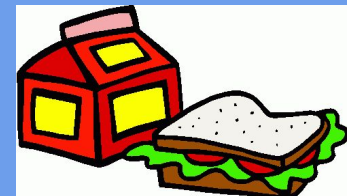
Student Medication




All medication, to include cough drops, must be given to the school nurse for proper distribution during the school day. Medication may not be brought to school by children.

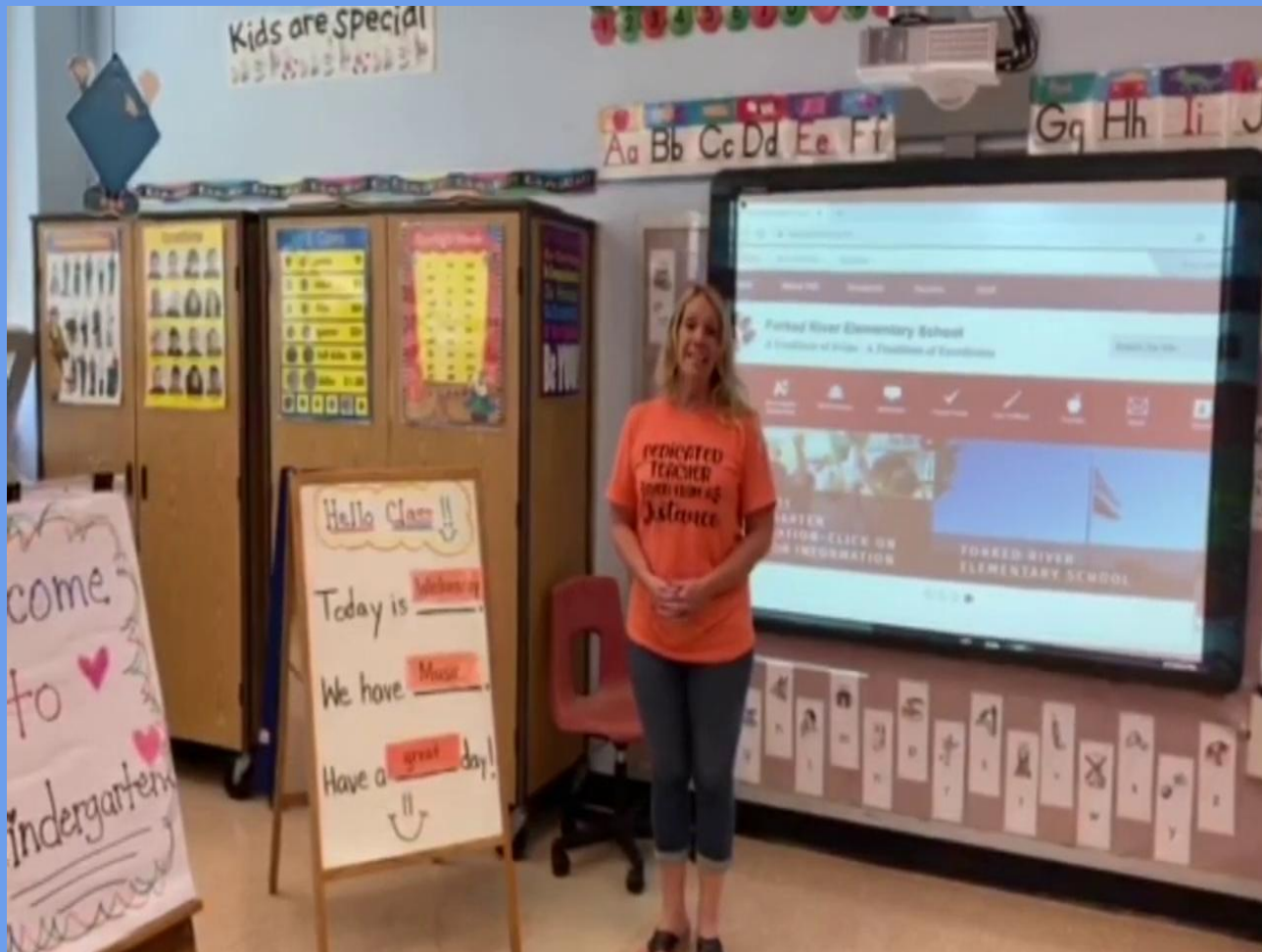
