Columbia University invites the world's top high school students to deepen their academic and college preparation through our Immersion programs this summer.



WHY COLUMBIA?

- **Rigorous Coursework**
Courses in subjects not typically offered at high schools span a dozen subject areas, ranging from neuroscience to understanding blockchain.
- **College Preparedness**
Attend seminars, workshops, and lectures to prepare for the college application process and the academic rigors of university life.

Instructors encourage students to think independently, critically, and creatively about complex and challenging material.
- **Earn a Columbia Certification of Completion and Personalized Evaluation Letter**

SUBJECT AREAS

Students take one course, choosing from more than 90 options, for an in-depth examination of a specific subject area. Subject areas include but aren't limited to:

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Complete online application
- Application fee
- Unofficial transcripts
- Personal essay
- Letter(s) of recommendation
- Writing sample (creative writing applicants only)
- Community standards consent form

Standardized test scores are not required. Upon admission, students provide official transcripts.

While international applicants are not required to submit scores, English proficiency should be equivalent to 90 or above on the TOEFL or at least 6.5 on the IELTS.

3-WEEK AND 1-WEEK OPTIONS

SCHEDULE

Classes in Session

Classes take place on Columbia's Morningside campus and meet twice daily—once in the morning and once in the afternoon, each with a ten-minute break.

Lunch and Midday Break

Students eat lunch, do homework, explore the neighborhood, relax with friends, and participate in a variety of organized activities and events.

Evenings and Weekends

Students experience campus life at an Ivy League institution in one of the greatest cities in the world. Residential students live on Columbia's historic campus and explore NYC through a variety of extracurricular activities curated to sample the arts and culture of the city. Students in the commuter program may take part in early-evening programming on weekdays, ending before 6:30 p.m.
