Dear Lacey Township School District Community:

The Lacey Township School District has lost over **\$14 million dollars** in state aid over the past 8 years. The aid was reduced as part of a school funding formula that lacked any limits to how much an individual district could lose from year to year. The result of these losses and the 2 percent tax levy cap that was in place prior to last year has left the Lacey Township School District with a lack of options to meet our financial responsibilities.

We ask that you reach out to our local and state legislators and appeal to them for help! The School District faces a financial crisis that leaves us critically short of funds if we do not receive state assistance or raise property taxes over **14 percent** for this year alone. The School District has done everything it can to reduce costs to include laying off teachers, outsourcing services and reconfiguring our schools to create efficiencies.
