Dear Parent/Guardian of Students in Grades 7 - 12,

As we prepare for the opening of schools, I draw your attention to some important information from the Office of Student Transportation.

Subscription Busing

In September 2017, the Lacey Township School District discontinued providing free transportation to students in grades 7 through 12 **who reside within the designated walking zone**. However, those students became, and remain eligible for the Subscription Busing Program.

The <u>application</u> for subscription busing can be found on the District website, under Departments & Programs, then Transportation. The program will run in conjunction with the **Hybrid A/B Cohort In-Person Instruction Model**. The fee will reflect the reduced number of in-person days of instruction. An application is required for each child.

The discounted annual fee for the Subscription Busing Program is as follows:

- \$85 per student (\$170 maximum per family)
- \$42 per student (\$84 maximum per family) Families eligible for Reduced National School Lunch Program
- \$21 per student (\$42 maximum per family) Families eligible for Free National School Lunch Program

Payment is due at time of registration by using the PaySchools Central website or payment to LTBOE at the address below. Bus pickup/drop off times and location will be available through the Parent Portal once it is opened for the school year.

Late Bus

Effective July 1, 2020 the Lacey Township School District is no longer able to provide bus routes for general education students attending after school clubs and activities.
