  - <u>High School Wrestling Room</u>:

  - Shared Services Agreement with Lacey Township Class 3 Officers:
    - Mr. DeGeorge presented a draft of a successor agreement with the Lacey Township municipality for Class 3 officers. The goal is to present the agreement for approval prior to June 30, 2022.
  - <u>Shared Services Agreement with Lacey Township Rental of Transportation Depot</u>:
    - Mr. DeGeorge led a discussion regarding the current agreement with the Lacey Township municipality for rental of the MUA's transportation depot. Mr. DeGeorge stated that he would provide that agreement to the board attorney to review and for the purpose of moving to a successor agreement.
  - Income Generation:
    - Board Member Klaus and Mr. DeGeorge led a brief discussion regarding methods of increasing revenue for the 2022-2023 school year budget and beyond. It was agreed that the focus of any fundraising ought to be; 1) purchasing technology for district

students and staff members, and 2) renovation of the wrestling room at the High School. Mr. DeGeorge stated that he would work with Committee Chairperson Mr. Scanlon to further the initiative.
