The meeting was called to order at 4:00 pm on February 7, 2023 with the following members in attendance:

Mr. Zylinski led a discussion of the transition that all schools will have to make as the state abandons the use of the discrepancy model to determine special education eligibility. This will include the timeline of when the changes will take place. A presentation was made by Ms. Frankie Jones of LinkIt that will possibly result in the district engaging her organization to provide the professional development to initiate and complete this change.

Mr. Joseph Bond and Mrs. Michelle Amos was also in attendance and presented on the upcoming changes and how the transition will take place and the professional development that will be required and how it will benefit all stakeholders as we initiate this significant change.

The ultimate result will be an upgrade of the entire I&RS process that will ensure that all students in the district are covered and supported by the New Jersey Multi Tiered System of Supports as required by the new state regulation being phased in.
