PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

BUS MAINTENANCE:

- 1. Provides own basic tools.
- 2. Assumes responsibility of maintenance and repair of all District owned vehicles to include repair of minor exterior body damage.
- 3. Maintains quarterly inspections and services as required by the N.J. Motor Vehicle Commission.
- 4. Conducts periodic inspections of all vehicles to ensure their safe condition.
- 5. Follows a program of required preventative maintenance for each school bus and reports these activities in an annual comprehensive bus maintenance plan.
- 6. Maintains schedules of work for each bus and ensures that proper supplies are on hand for necessary repairs and for preventative maintenance.
- 7. Ensures that all N.J. Motor Vehicle inspection requirements and regulations are enforced.
- 8. Maintains a system of school bus cleaning to include washing and removal of minor scratch and rust spots during each quarterly inspection.
- 9. Performs all other related duties as required for the safe operation of school vehicles.

SUPERVISION OF STAFF:

- 1. Schedules daily tasks of the mechanics and participates in the daily repair of school vehicles.
- 2. Assists the Transportation Coordinator with the selection, assignment, scheduling and training of mechanics staff.
- 3. Evaluates the performance of mechanics in accordance with Board guidelines.
